Indent quotations (style: Quotation) by ½" (1.27 cm) on both the left and the right with no first-line indentation and with 12-point spacing before and after each quotation. Retain full justification. Quotations of 100 words or more must be separated and indented, but shorter quotations may also be indented.

### **Sub-Heading**

You should only use four levels of heading: the article title, main headings, subheadings, and sub-sub-headings. If you use subheadings or sub-sub-headings, you should use at least two for each higher-level heading. Capitalize all major words in each level of heading, but do not use all capitals.

#### Sub-Sub-Heading

All the styles you should need are in the style bar. Please do not change any of them. You can use this file as a template or load the template separately. Please ensure the paper size is set to Letter, not A4, and there are 1" (2.54 cm) margins all round.
